5	Module Overview
<p>Rationale/ Indicative content</p> <p>This module attends to both historical and contemporary models of practice in relationship to the emergence of queer theory. We will explore a range of art practices and queer methods that critique or subvert dominant modes of representation and operation. Focus is given to the following areas: Introduction to queer theory, Art beyond representation, Queer Speech, Queer horror, Education and transgression, Queering the Archive; Care; Queer reading.</p> <p>The intention is to offer a range of ways to understand existing queer strategies for arts based production that will allow you to develop your own methods of working queerly within the context of making and writing.</p>	

6	Indicative Content
<p>This taught module consists of ten two hour seminars (normally one per week over 10 weeks) delivered in Semester 1. This module is led by a specialist module tutor and includes formal presentations, reading directed extracts from primary and secondary texts, group discussion, student led seminar presentations and one to one tutorial support.</p>
