<p>The ability to work collaboratively in a team is a vital employability skill within the Creative Industries. This module is an opportunity to learn and critically reflect on the skills of collaboration by enabling you to create a group project with students from complementary disciplines.</p>

<p>Your project supervisor will determine the project you undertake and the students you work with. The module content will reflect the nature of the project. Typically, it includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Subject specific lectures/workshops to introduce knowledge and skills relevant to the project and discipline. • Lectures/workshops to introduce principles and techniques of collaboration and effective teamwork, including the importance of team roles and the use of online tools to enable collaboration. • Group working activities, including online, to enable you to experience group projects within your own subject discipline. • One or more 'networking' events, in which you will be introduced to your fellow collaborators – to form groups. • An opportunity for each group to work collaboratively to create a project in response to a pre-determined theme, supported by tutorials. • An opportunity for groups to present the outcomes of their project and reflect on the process of collaboration.
