5	Module Overview
<p>The purpose of this module is to enable you to develop professional attributes and subject skills through experience in the work place, and to critically reflect upon your learning in that context. You will normally be expected to arrange your own placement, with support from academic staff and ADM Careers+.</p> <p>Typically, the placement duration is a minimum 70 hours, maximum of 140 hours. This can be achieved in one block, or can be dispersed over a longer period of time, if required.</p> <p>If a student fails to secure a placement by the specified deadline, an “as live” industry standard project will be set by the Module Tutor.</p> <p>The work placement will be considered and approved by the Module tutor in order to ensure that the learning opportunity is of benefit to you. BCU procedures for assuring the health and safety of students on placement will be followed.</p>
