5	Module Overview
<p>The Practice and Professional Presentation module builds on the student's prior imaginative, practical and theoretical investigations. This sustained and extended period of individual self-directed study time requires careful planning and organisation. The module is a necessarily extended period of time allowing for deeper level of learning and for the synthesis of accrued theoretical, creative, technical and practical knowledge and skills. This is consolidated in a fully resolved and coherent body of artwork presented at a professional level.</p>	

6	Indicative Content
<p>Independent study and peer learning is critical. Students will be engaged in tutorials and critiques, study visits and professional practice activity. Mid-way through the module the student will have a significant formative review on their work. The feedback from this will identify where the content, form or techniques and organisation of their time need to be further strengthened and enhanced.</p>
