5	Module Overview
<p>The purpose of the module is to enable you to undertake a production project in the subject specialism of your choosing, exploring an area that is of personal interest to you. The outcome can take the form of a written or a practice-based outcome. You will be able to evaluate and reflect critically on your work. Your final work will be a key step in your progression as a student of the media and as a media worker. You will be expected to work independently for the most part but you will receive one-to-one support from a supervisor as well as being able to connect with wider support within the School's academic team.</p> <p>The module is organised around two key stages:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Development of a proposal of the project with intended outputs and outcomes. • Realisation of the project. <p>Your completed project will reflect your ability to successfully plan and implement a major piece of academic work.</p>
