5	<b>Module Overview</b>
<p><b>Rationale</b></p> <p>This module aims to support you to develop independent learning and advanced scholarship which may be employed to support your continuing professional development. You will be studying the role that leadership plays within wider health contexts such as during periods of change and transformation of service delivery. You will develop academic skills that will allow you to interrogate evidence that supports aspects of your clinical practice which will allow you to act with confidence and autonomy within your own scope of responsibility.</p> <p><b>Alignment with programme Philosophy and Aims</b></p> <p>This module will support the philosophy of the programme that relates to the application of knowledge, skills and attitudes inherent in advanced practice and which extends the boundaries of professional knowledge. This module supports those students who intend to strive as participants of practice development and change. This module will support your role as a practitioner and will help you develop an awareness of the importance of effective leadership within the wider context of delivery of patient-centred service delivery.</p> <p>Employers will be seen as real partners in your learning and we are proud of the links we have with clinical partners, not only enhance your learning, but also to ensure you can apply your knowledge and thus succeed in your chosen career pathway. We will further develop your employability by developing a range of knowledge skills, behaviours and attributes which will enable you to be successful in employment.</p> <p>The recognition of our qualifications on an international stage means your skills will be able to contribute to the healthcare of the global community. We have developed relationships with overseas institutions and welcome international students.</p> <p><b>Learning and Teaching</b></p> <p>This module is delivered in blocks of study (typically a series of study days). Your learning will include attendance at the university where you will receive taught lectures and seminars from academic members of staff and visiting teachers who are leaders in their field. These sessions are common to all the postgraduate radiography pathways, and you will share your experiences from your own work practice and experiences with your peers. Independent study is a core aspect of this module- you will develop and practice literature searching skills which will help you consolidate this skill which will support the retrieval of literature in other modules you may go on to study. You will also be revisiting core aspects of academic skills such as critical reading and writing, and will be consolidating your own reflective practice.</p>
