5 Module Overview

Aims of the Module:

To provide opportunities for the student to:

- Develop understanding of the physical, social and psychological factors relating to the management of long term conditions.
- Enhance critical awareness of the influence that government policy has on the delivery of care for patients with long term conditions in the community.
- Investigate and critically analyse evidence based solutions to the management of long term conditions in the community.
- Develop holistic, problem solving approaches to the management of long term conditions in the community.
- Examine the role of the multi-disciplinary team in the care, management and treatment of long term conditions.

6 Indicative Content

This module focuses upon the aspects of managing long term conditions in the community, emphasising on developing a partnership with the patient and utilisation of evidence based practice. This includes:

- National Policy that impacts on the delivery of care to meet the needs of patients with long term conditions in the community.
- Aetiology of long term conditions
- Epidemiology of long term conditions and community data analysis.
- Health Promotion and education to facilitate patient management of long term conditions
- Evidence based care and management of long term conditions
- Patient empowerment and self care models
- Roles and responsibilities within the multidisciplinary team.
